Hello CFS Family

It's been a cracking start to the year and some experts are saying this has been one of the smoothest, calmest starts to the year in living memory. I would like to commend all the children and families and staff who have helped make this happen.

Inevitably, when children return from six weeks holiday and are subject to the rules, routines and expectations of the classroom, there will be some adjustment issues, and each child has a unique way of making such adjustments.

As such, I think it is timely to remind the school community of the expectations with regard to general conduct in and around the school

All Northern Territory (NT) government schools follow a code of behaviour which sets standards and expectations of behaviour in schools, what is unacceptable behaviour and the consequences that may follow.

Every school has a behaviour plan based on the code of behaviour and the National Safe Schools Framework.

This is developed in consultation with parents and the school community. It is targeted at:

- providing the opportunity for all students to learn and teachers to teach
- ensuring the safety of staff and students
- assisting students who show unacceptable behaviour to accept responsibility for themselves and their actions.

Any extreme behaviour that impacts the safety of students and teachers or disrupts learning is not acceptable.

Unacceptable behaviour includes all of the following:

- assault
- verbal abuse
- property offences - including theft or damage
- substance use or possession
- weapons offences
- obscene or offensive acts
- consistent unproductive behaviour that interferes with the wellbeing, safety or educational opportunities of any other student.



Schools have a responsibility to students and staff to provide safe and supportive learning environments, which enable all students to engage in meaningful experiences both in and out of the classroom.

I have re-started the Behaviour Support Group (BSUP) for students who have committed or threatened acts of violence in class or the playground. Students in BSUP are monitored closely before school, and at recess and lunch to prevent further incidents, and counselling is provided to identify and overcome triggers to their behaviour. If your child is placed in the BSUP, you will be notified, and as a team we will work together to resolve any issues.

I hope we can continue to work together as February gets away from us, and enjoy the rain and these cooler days while they last.
